

# Convention Trip Rules/Health Form

You are a representative of North Central High School, the staff and yourself. **THIS IS A SCHOOL-SPONSORED TRIP.** The people we will meet on this trip will form their opinions of you and our program within the first five seconds of meeting you. It will be based on the way you are dressed and the way you act, rather than on the person we all know you to be. Be sure your actions and appearance create an impression that you will be proud of. First impressions, good or bad, are not quickly forgotten. All school rules and school board policies are in force during the entire duration of this trip. Your luggage is subject to search by school personnel or school-appointed chaperones at any time during the trip. Your room is subject to search by school personnel or school-appointed chaperones at any time during the trip. You are expected to report any violation of rules, policies or state/federal law to school personnel or a chaperone.

Basically, your conduct on this trip should be that of regular school hours. Any legal violation will result in your immediate dismissal from the convention. Your parents and proper school officials will be contacted and you will be sent home at your own expense.

Students are not to venture out on their own. Anytime students leave the hotel, they must contact a chaperone. We will have a written record of where everyone is at all times. During session times, you are expected to be in a session. We will meet regularly as an entire group.

For student safety, students are not to enter a vehicle while attending the convention unless it is public transportation or an official hotel shuttle.

Boys and girls should never be in rooms of the other gender.

Behavior at speakers should be exceptional. Cell phones should be put away. Passing of notes and playing of games should not take place.

The use of alcohol and other illegal substances is strictly forbidden. All students are to follow local, state and federal laws while in the jurisdiction of Mr. Gayda and local and state law enforcement agencies.

A midnight curfew for students is effect each night. Students should be in their rooms making no excessive noise at that time.

Students will be held liable for any damage to hotel room and facilities.

Rudeness to other guests or hotel employees will not be tolerated. Such behavior could result in the dismissal of our entire group.

Convention namebadges should be worn in the hotel and at the convention, but not while touring.
