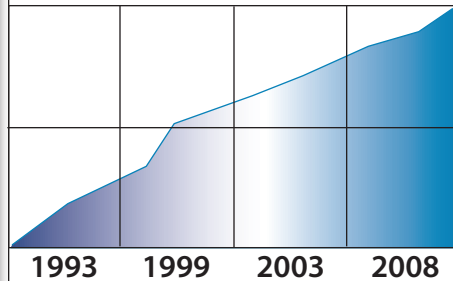
### TIMELINE

## Journalism Terms

- Byline:** where the name of the reporter appears  
**Cutline:** another name for a caption  
**Kerning:** controlling the amount of space between letters  
**Leading:** spacing between lines of type  
**Mug Shot:** a tightly-cropped photo of a person's head  
**Pica:** 1/6 of an inch  
**Point:** 1/12 of a pica  
**Text:** the words that comprise a story

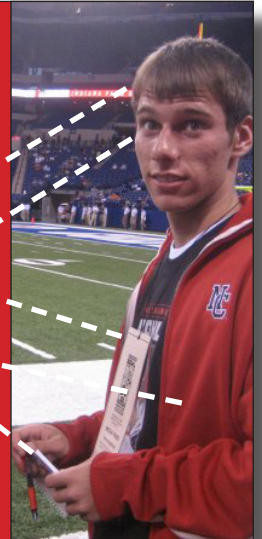

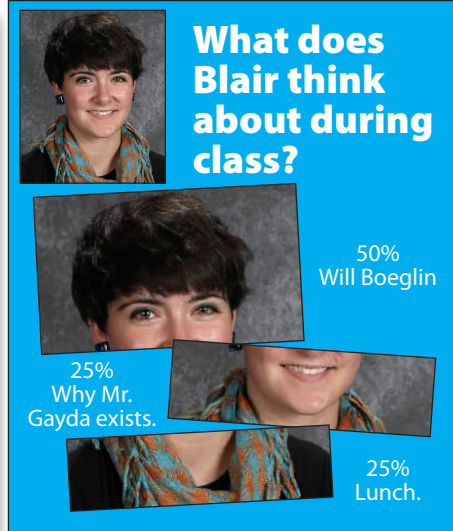

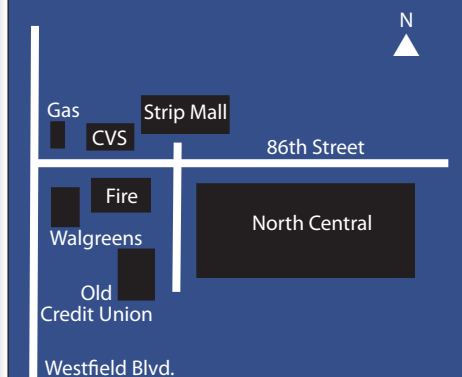
